ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

1. *Application
 2. Completed medical form by physician
 3. **Results of TOEFL examination or other proof of proficiency in the English language. The test score must be a minimum of 550.
 4. School transcripts translated into English
 5. Letter or other proof of ability to meet expenses for one year. This can be sworn affidavits, bank statements, or other legal documents.

6. Student must carry a minimum of 12 hours.
7. F-1 students are not permitted to work off campus during their first school year.
8. Pastor's Recommendation
9. Application fee of \$15.00

*Essay as indicated on the application

**Non-English Speaking

After all of the above have been satisfied, the student will be sent a completed copy of the 1-20 form. The student should then apply for a student visa through the United States Embassy or consulate. It is strongly suggested that foreign students make application for student visas before leaving their native country. Immigration services will not issue student visas to persons residing in the United States.

Also, please be informed that International students are required to deposit \$5,000.00 (U.S. dollars) toward their school expenses when they report to the school.

If the student:

- a. Does not report on the expected date,
- b. Does not register for 12 hours,
- c. Does not maintain regular attendance in classes,
- d. Fails to maintain at least a "C" average,
- e. Drops all courses, or
- f. Does not stay current with his/her school finances

The immigration authorities must be notified.
